I. Meeting Opening

BME provided an overview of the agenda to start the meeting.

II. Update: RPHN Resignation

a. Aine Studdert-Kennedy shared an update regarding Kristen McIntire's anticipated resignation from her role as the Regional Public Health Nurse, effective Friday, April

25th. On Kristen's behalf, Aine conveyed her interest in continuing in a part-time capacity, should that align with the coalition's needs. Based on Human Resources policies in Dedham, Kristen's host community, a part-time arrangement would likely fall within the 15–19 hours per week range.

b. Aine noted that the primary decision point for the meeting was to vote on whether to retain Kristen in a part-time capacity. If time permitted, the group could also begin discussions on the longer-term vision for the role.

III. Discussion: Community Nursing Needs

a. The group discussed the role and expressed general support for retaining Kristen McIntire in a part-time capacity after her proposed resignation date.

IV. Action Item: Vote on RPHN Next Steps

Meg Goldstein motioned to approve the proposal to retain Kristen McIntire in a part-time capacity—up to 19 hours per week or on a per diem basis—through the end of FY25, or until a full-time replacement is secured. The motion allows for flexibility in revisiting the timeline for evaluating the role at a later date. Stacey Lane seconded the motion.
